Chad King (Riverbat ‘07) (St John Fisher, JR) was named 1st team Empire 8 at 2nd base. King was also named 2nd team as a pitcher. King hit .352 with 7 doubles, 4 triples, 2 homeruns and 27 rbi’s. On the mound King’s ERA was 1.70 and kept the opposition to a 0.218 batting average. The Cardinals won the ECAC upstate tourney and gained an at-large bid in the NCAA DIII regionals beginning May 16th at Auburn, NY.

Dan Benz (Riverbat ‘06, ‘07) (Williams, SO) Williams sophomore LHP Dan Benz was named NESCAC Pitcher of the Week. Benz hurled a one-hit, complete-game shutout against Bowdoin on Friday as the Ephs picked up a 1-0 win over the Polar Bears in the opening game of the 2007 NESCAC Baseball Championship. After a very rough season start allowing 16 earned runs in 17.2 innings pitched Benz has allowed only 1 earned run in his last thirty innings pitched. He currently has a 3.21 ERA. Williams went on to win the NESCAC Championship and an automatic bid to the NCAA DIII regionals beginning May 16th in Harwich, MA.
